ANNOUNCING ONE (1) NEW COVID-19 CASE, 2nd BOOSTERS NOW BEING SCHEDULED, FREE PULSE OXIMETERS, AT-HOME TESTS, KN95 MASKS, and N95 MASKS.

May 23, 2022

• The GTB Health Department is reporting seven (7) new positive COVID-19 case for the workweek ending May 20, 2022. Our most recent 7-day positivity rate was 2.7% (compared to 16% for the State of Michigan). In the month of May 2022, we reported nineteen (19) positives in total. We reported 96 new cases for January 2022, 22 new cases for February 2022, and 3 new cases for March 2022 and 3 new cases for April 2022.

<u>Currently, all GTB service areas are in medium or high community level risk.</u> You can check your CDC COVID-19 community levels at <u>https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/your-health/covid-by-county.html</u>.

In Michigan, new cases are showing an increasing trend in all regions. Hospital admissions and hospital census are showing an increase, although ICU census continues to decline. We continue to closely monitor the spread of Omicron BA.2 in Michigan. In the U.S., BA.2 remains most predominant but the proportion of BA.2.12.1 is increasing faster than other lineages. BA.2.12.1 is the most common circulating strain in Northeastern U.S. In Michigan, since March 15, there have been 947 Omicron BA.2 specimens identified from 57 counties and City of Detroit.

The GTB Health Department has now administered 5,411 doses. Currently, 63% of GTB tribal members age 12 and over, 82% of GTB elders age 55 and over, and 19% of GTB tribal members age 5 to 11 years in the 6-county service area are vaccinated. Additionally, 65% of eligible GTB Elders have received their 1st booster and 60% of eligible GTB Elders have received their 2nd booster.
