Tribal Court Administrative Order 2020-05

ORDER TEMPORARILY SUSPENDING FACILITY TESTING FOR PRELIMINARY BREATH TEST REQUIREMENTS UNDER COURT ORDERS

In light of the current COVID-19 pandemic and the lack of available testing sites for preliminary breath tests (PBTs), all current court orders that require individuals to submit to PBTs at a testing facility are hereby temporarily suspended. Individuals who are on probation or have been released pending trial ("on bond") who have been ordered via bond order, probation order, sentencing order, or a like order to submit to PBTs at a facility for scheduled onsite testing are relieved of that requirement under the applicable order until further notice of the Court.

Individuals who are required by bond order, probation order, sentencing order, or the like to submit to PBTs through home monitoring using individual monitoring machines or other equipment are still ordered to submit to PBTs as stated within the applicable order.

The Prosecuting Attorney's Office may motion in any pending case or ongoing probation to amend a bond or probation order to include home monitoring PBTs for any individual who was ordered to submit to regular PBTs at a facility for onsite testing so long as the applicable bond or probation order was in effect prior to the issuance of this administrative order.

This administrative order shall have no effect on any violation or alleged violation for violating a court order when said violation or alleged violation took place prior to the effective date of this administrative order.
