



# Pollution Prevention

## TYPES OF POLLUTION



- Toxic Chemicals  
Ex. Fuel, engine oil, antifreeze, marine paints, cleaning products, etc

- Trash  
Ex. Plastics, fishing line, paper, wood, metal, etc



- Human and food waste  
\*Can cause, but not limited to, algal blooms and disease in water system\*

## CLEAN BOATING PRACTICES

### OIL/GAS SPILL PREVENTION



- Bilge Pillow to absorb oil & gas
- Do NOT drain engine fluids into water
- Regular engine & fuel line inspections/maintenance
- Bring used oil to Grand Traverse Band automotive department 231-534-7705



### NON-NATIVE/INVASIVE SPECIES PREVENTION

- Drain bilge water before leaving one waterway and entering another
- Empty bait buckets onshore in trash receptacles


