- (7) I will fulfill the confidence placed in me and live up to the expectations of the tribal membership as expressed by my election;
- (8) I will strive to preserve the unique legal status of Indian tribes and be ever vigilant against the erosion of tribal sovereignty;
- (9) I will be ever vigilant to avoid conflicts-of-interest; and
- (10) I will work for the best interests of the Tribe in all matters at all times.
